



Subscribe and purchase the "Portals of Prayer" access on your laptop or desktop PC by visiting their website https://www1.cph.org/portals/default.aspx#options

NOTE: both the desktop version and phone app require you to purchase a yearly subscription for \$10 per year. In addition to new daily devotions, subscribers have access to seven years of past devotions — more than 2,500 meditations and prayers that are "searchable" using a keyword. Users can save favorite readings and share prayers. There is a play button at the top of each devotion to hear the audio, or scroll down the page to read the devotion and prayer.
